Asturias

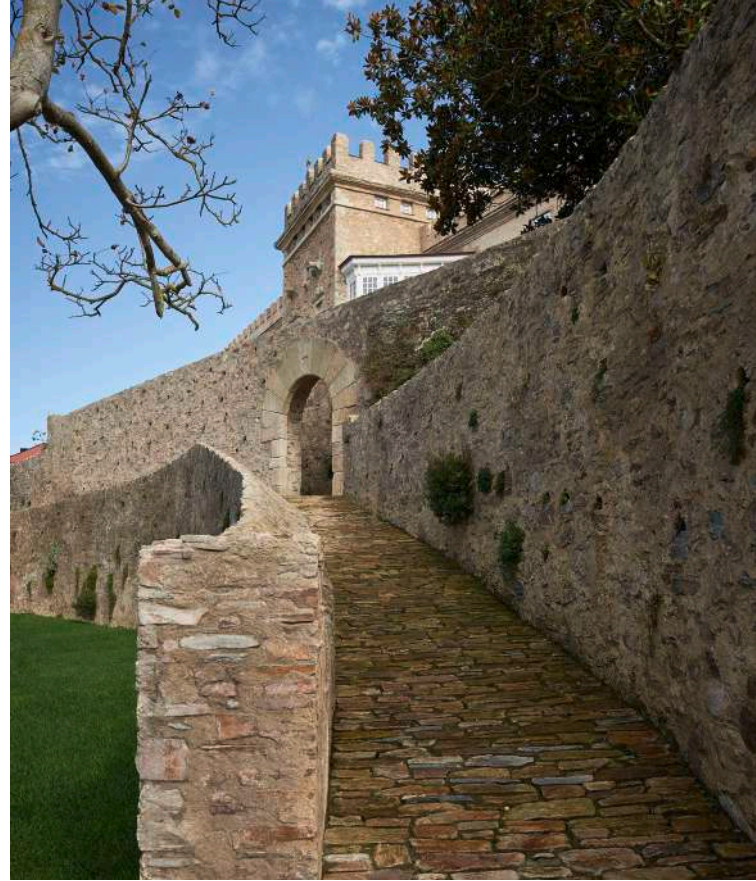
Asturias' gorgeously green scenery is a heady mix of soaring mountains and lush valleys, dense forests, flowing rivers and burbling streams. Dotted with colourful fishing ports and sweeping golden beaches, the coast is wild and dramatic, and the perfect place to feast on sublime seafood. Visit any local town or village to uncover the region's reputation for a fiercely independent spirit. Home to the most UNESCO-designated Biosphere Reserves in the country, Asturias takes the preservation of its unspoilt countryside seriously. For architecture lovers, Asturias is the land of the pre-Romanesque, with remarkable examples found in the ancient capital city of Oviedo. Famed for its abundant gastronomy, Asturias has a proud food and drink culture: taste wholesome stews, cave-matured cheeses, and visit organic vineyards. Popular amongst walkers who traverse the Camino de Santiago, the region has two routes along the infamous pilgrim trail.





Palacio de Figueras: a labour of love

The Palacio de Figueras, home to the Pardo de Donlebún family for 500 years, has been painstakingly and lovingly restored to its former glory. The aim: to strip back any superfluous additions and uncover the original bones of this sublime 16th-century property, and now, once more, it stands proud on the hill above the glittering Eo estuary. The central tower and both crenellated wings comprise 11 spoiling bedrooms including two majestic suites, comfortable and spacious common areas, high-end kitchens and modern bathrooms. Surrounded by lush, landscaped gardens, this is a unique location for exclusive weddings, special events and unforgettable holidays. Having uncovered the true character and essence of this venerable building, it has been recognised for its important architectural significance and declared an Asset of Cultural Interest. We are proud to be the guardians of its legacy by allowing it to play a part in the future of Asturias.



Restoration

The 11-year restoration of the Palacio de Figueras was undertaken with a deep respect for the building's original structure and materials, as well as its status as a historic building. To honour the building we worked with craftspeople with rare skills, and the ability to recreate the beauty of the past whilst incorporating the best modern comforts for a relaxed stay. Every material and item has been carefully sourced or restored using ancient techniques. This painstaking revival has resulted in a remarkable property that will live on into the future.

A prime position overlooking the glittering Eo estuary, Palacio de Figueras enjoys an enviable location in the heart of Asturias, near pretty fishing ports, including Cudillero, and the ancient capital city of Oviedo. Inland you can discover the delights of the Picos de Europa - Spain's most spectacular mountain scenery.

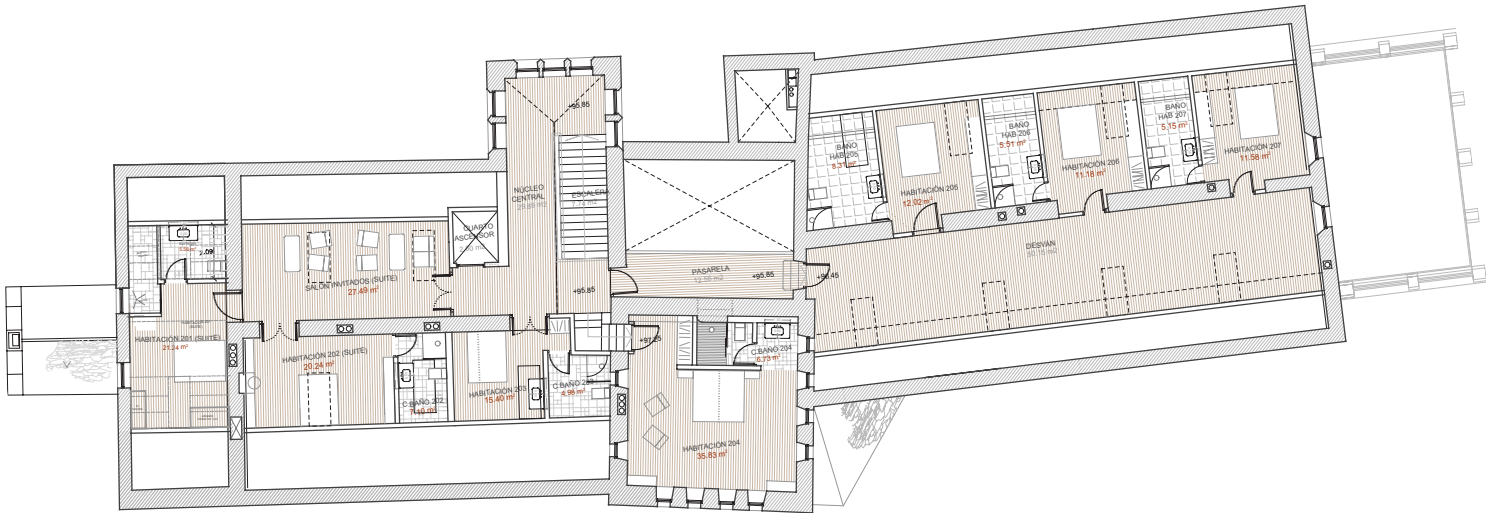

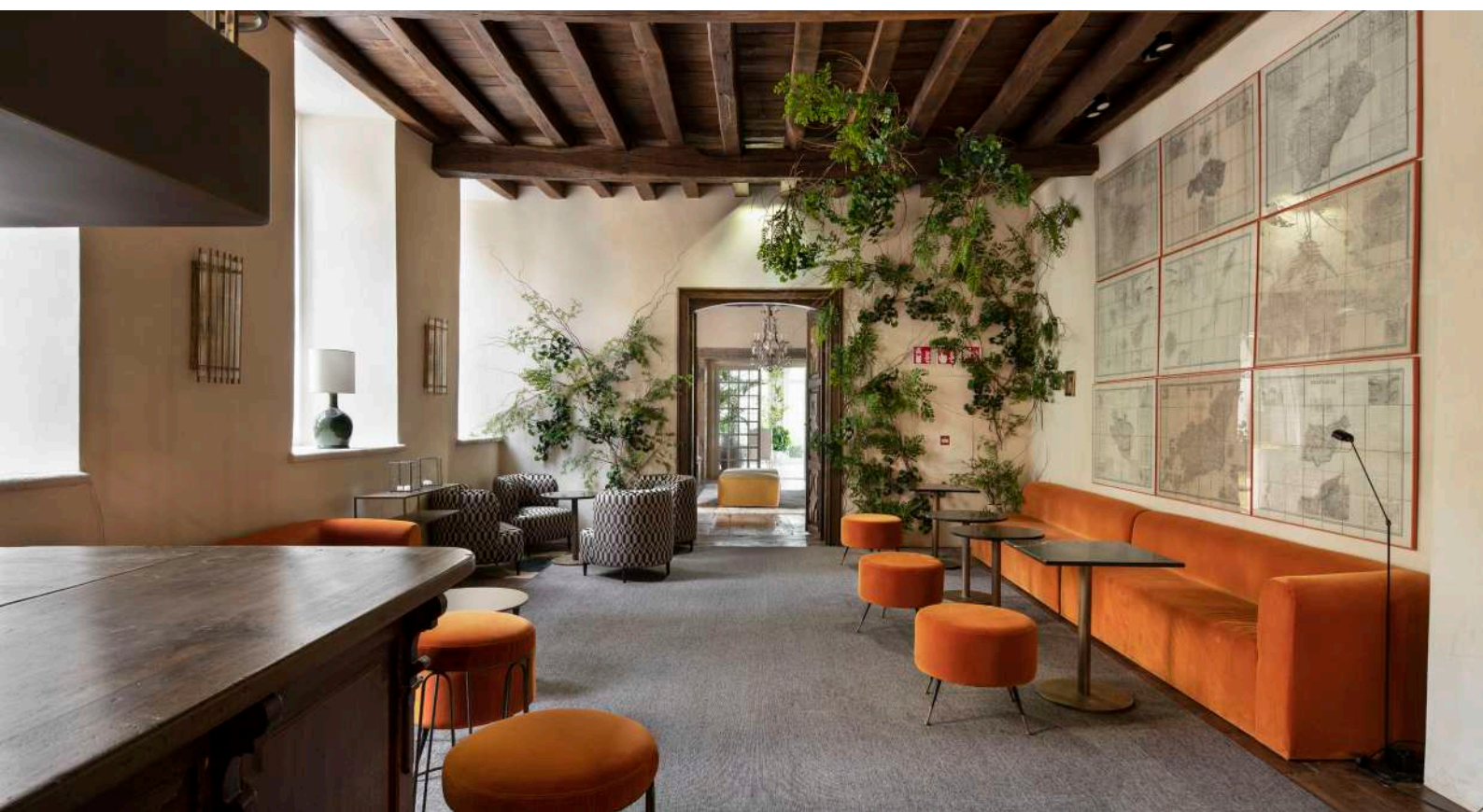
First Floor
